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**Brady Linen Services Merges with AC Linen Supply;
Merger Forms One-of-a-Kind National Hospitality Laundry Company**

***As part of expansion, new company announces the hiring of J.R. Garcia,
formerly of Walt Disney Resorts and Parks***

Las Vegas, NV – Brady Linen Services (“Brady”) has merged with AC Linen Supply, LLC (“ACL”). ACL and Brady are the two leading hospitality laundry service providers on the West and East coasts respectively, and the combined company is now the nation’s first bi-coastal hospitality laundry company. This merger follows ACL’s recent acquisition of Royal Hospitality (“Royal”) – the largest hospitality laundry operator in Boston, MA.

Alvarez & Marsal Capital (“A&M Capital”), a middle-market private equity firm that has a strategic association with Alvarez & Marsal (“A&M”), has a majority interest in the partnership and the new expanded company.

Based in Las Vegas, NV, Brady operates five laundry facilities and produces in excess of 1-million pounds of laundry per day. Brady has been in operation for nearly 15 years, and Eric Brady will continue in his role as President of Brady Linen, and will assume the position of Co-CEO for A&M Capital’s umbrella portfolio company, along with brothers Dan and Eric Goldberg of ACL.

“We are excited to partner with AC Linen and A&M Capital, as we work to build the first national hospitality laundry company,” said Mr. Brady. “We took great care with the decision to expand, and we could be not happier with the partners we have chosen. We truly believe we have created a one of a kind organization in our industry,” Mr. Brady continued.

On a combined basis, the three companies, ACL, Brady and Royal, operate eleven facilities across the nation, including locations in Las Vegas, Boston, Philadelphia, Atlantic City and Norwich, CT. A twelfth facility will open in the Bahamas in 2015 as part of the Baha Mar hotel-resort development.

Mike Odrich, A&M Capital's Managing Partner, said, "We are particularly excited about the Brady transaction because it has elevated our linen platform company into the leading hospitality-focused commercial laundry in the country. We are proud to have helped create this national organization in the span of less than one year following our initial investment into AC Linen."

As part of this continued expansion, the company also announced the hiring of J.R. Garcia, the former Director of Laundry Operations for Walt Disney Resort and Parks. Mr. Garcia is the Executive Vice President of the Eastern Region, and is working across facilities on both the East and West coasts to integrate best practices and promote operational excellence.

"Having J.R. as part of our growing family is truly exciting. He brings tremendous experience and passion, and paired with our new partners at Brady, we have collectively assembled an all-star team of laundry talent and know how," said Dan Goldberg, Co-CEO and President of ACL.
